**ORDER**

For the reasons stated in the accompanying Memorandum Opinion, it is, this 12th day of November, 2013, ORDERED that:

A) Plaintiff's Partial Motion for Summary Judgment as to liability, ECF No. 52, is GRANTED as to Count I: Breach of Duty of Loyalty, and otherwise is DENIED.

B) Within twenty-one days of this Order, Plaintiff shall:

1) SHOW CAUSE as to why Count X: Accounting and Count XI: Declaratory Relief should not be dismissed as moot;

2) SHOW CAUSE as to why summary judgment in favor of Defendant should not be granted with respect to Count V: Civil Conspiracy, Count XII: Civil Conspiracy, Count XIII: Breach of Contract, and Count XIV: Unjust Enrichment;
