In January of 2002, Judge Gallagher was appointed as an Assistant United States Attorney for the District of Maryland, where she served until September of 2008 prosecuting criminal cases ranging from fraud to violent crime. In October of 2008, Judge Gallagher co-founded Levin & Gallagher LLC, a litigation boutique handling both civil and criminal matters.
