ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2003-3

At its September 2002 session, the Judicial Conference of the United States approved a ten percent increase in the maximum per page rates which may be charged for court transcripts. The increase was contingent upon funding in the Defender Services budget. On March 14, 2003, the Court was notified that such funding was included and that each court could adopt a schedule of fees up to the maximum rates established by the Judicial Conference.

Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** that for any transcripts produced pursuant to orders or authorizations which are received by the Court Reporters on or after March 25, 2003, Official Court Reporters may charge the following rates:

Ordinary Transcript (to be delivered within thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of order)	Original: \$3.30/page First copy to each party: \$.83/page Each addnl. copy to same party: \$.55/page
Expedited Transcript (to be delivered within seven (7) calendar days after receipt of order)	Original: \$4.40/page First copy to each party: \$.83/page Each addnl. copy to same party: \$.55/page
Daily Transcript (to be delivered following an adjournment and prior to the normal opening hour of the court on the following morning regardless of whether it is an actual court day)	Original: \$5.50/page First copy to each party: \$1.10/page Each addnl. copy to same party: \$.83/page
Hourly Transcript (to be delivered within two (2) hours)	Original: \$6.60/page First copy to each party: \$1.10/page Each addnl. copy to same party: \$.83/page

Realtime Transcript

(draft, unedited version by a certified realtime reporter to be delivered electronically during the proceedings or immediately after adjournment)

Original: \$2.75/page

First copy to each party: \$1.10/page

It is further **ORDERED** that any transcripts produced pursuant to orders or authorizations received by the Court Reporters prior to March 25, 2003 shall be billed at the amounts in effect at the time the order was placed.
