ORDERED that, pursuant to Federal Rule of Criminal Procedure 58(d)(1) and Local Rule 304.2 of the United States District Court for the District of Maryland, this Court's schedule of monetary collateral and mandatory offenses adopted April 1, 1988, and June 19, 1995, and amended February 9, 2003, be amended as follows:

National Security Agency: The collateral to be set or mandatory appearances to be required under this heading shall be in accordance with the schedule set forth in Exhibit 1-NSA, attached to this Order and titled "National Security Agency Police 32 CFR 288 Collateral Schedule."

Nothing contained in this Order shall supersede the procedure authorized by Local Rule 304.

This Order shall become effective on January 1, 2012, and shall apply to offenses committed on or after the effective date.
