## **STANDING ORDER 2024-03**

Any paper grand jury voting records dated less than ten (10) years prior to the entry of this Order may be destroyed after scanning and filing such records in CM/ECF. All grand jury voting records maintained by the Clerk's Office in paper form dated more than ten (10) years prior to the entry of this Order shall be destroyed whether or not filed in CM/ECF.
