Visitors may be asked to show this form and/or the results of a negative COVID-19 test upon entry to a courthouse. **Please maintain this form in your possession during your visit.**

**I understand that if I decline to respond or am not fully vaccinated, I must comply with the following safety protocols while in the Courthouse:**

- Provide proof of having received a negative COVID-19 test administered within the previous 72 hours, unless I am excepted from doing so.

**I am excepted from providing a negative COVID-19 test because (if applicable):**

I am a lay witness under subpoena or request from counsel to testify in a criminal case or before a Grand Jury.

<sup>1</sup> Persons are considered fully vaccinated against COVID-19 fourteen days after receiving the second dose of a two-dose vaccine, or fourteen days after receiving a single dose of a one-dose vaccine.

<sup>2</sup> Either you have received your first dose of the Moderna or Pfizer vaccine, and your second appointment is scheduled, or you received your final dose less than fourteen days ago.

<sup>3</sup> If you are not vaccinated due to medical or religious reasons, please check either "I have not been vaccinated" or "I decline to respond."
