**Notice of 2026 Attorney Renewal Process and Deadlines**

In order to comply with Local Rule 701.2.b, members of this bar wishing to maintain an active bar status are required to periodically renew their memberships.

The current membership term is six years, and the renewal fee is **\$75.00**. All active members of the bar must renew their memberships electronically through CM/ECF. **Your PACER account must be linked to your CM/ECF account for the District of Maryland to renew your membership.** Instructions on how to link your PACER and CM/ECF accounts can be found [here](#).
